**JARUZELSKI
' IS KREMLIN
PUPPET '**

Mr Zdzislaw Rurar's, Poland's former ambassador to Japan said yesterday that Moscow had already intervened in Poland through the martial law regime which he called a puppet junta.

"The Polish drama is not, I emphasise, not of Polish making," said Mr Rurarz, who defected on Christmas Eve. "Those really responsible sit behind the walls of the Kremlin," he said.

He had a joint Congressional commission t h a t Gen. Jaruzelski was "a traitor who is playing the dirtiest game in Polish history. . . . "Poland is not really Poland," he said. "We are really fighting the Soviet union."
